Scientific Display Rules

The following rules and regulations apply to all who submit scientific displays for competition at the *Michigan Society of Radiologic Technologists Annual Meeting*

I. Awards

- a. Awards for registered technologist have been suspended indefinitely.**
- b. The MSRT will continue to award for student presentations as part of our scholarship activities.**

First Place: \$250.00 (Plus 1 yr membership to MSRT)

Second Place: \$125.00

Third Place: \$ 75.00

II. Eligibility

1. Applicants must be an active, associate or student member in good standing with the MSRT
2. A copy of current membership card must accompany the application for each name on the application. Membership may be applied for at the time of the application.
3. Multiple co-displays is acceptable, however, only one prize will be awarded for each place.

III. Application Procedure

1. Applications must be received (or post marked) by the Scientific Display Chairperson on or before September 1st. Late applications will not be eligible for prize awards in the competition.
2. The official application form for the MSRT ***Radiologic Technologist Scientific Display*** must be used. Incomplete or improper form will be returned to the applicant for correction/completion and must be returned by the date specified on the application. This form may be photocopied.

IV. Preparation of Display

1. Application(s) shall be submitted in the name(s) of the displayer(s).
2. Displays **WILL NOT** show any image or marking that could identify the patient/subject, institution, department, school or display author. Any such image or marking will disqualify the entry.
3. Subject matter will be pertinent to the Radiological Sciences.
4. The entire display must be contained within the allotted space.
5. Illuminations will not be provided. Displayers are responsible for illuminators.
6. Displays must be the work of the displayer(s).
7. Any quotes or reproduced reference material must have proper citation .

8. Displays must not have been shown at any other meeting to be eligible for the competition.
9. Displayers may share their works and not be in the competition if they so desire.

V. Installation and Dismantling

1. Display space will be assigned by the Scientific Display Committee.
2. Displays that do not meet the published criteria will not be eligible for competition judging.
3. Specific set-up and tear-down times will be forwarded to applicant by letter from Scientific Display Chairperson.
4. Each displayer will be responsible for their display.
5. If a displayer is unable to install and/or dismantle their display, they may designate another to do so. Notification of such designation must be made in writing to the Scientific Display Chairperson prior to assigned day of installation/dismantling.
6. Displays will be dismantled by the time specified by the Scientific Display Committee.
7. Displayer is responsible for the removal of their display.
8. Displays that are not dismantled/removed from display hall by the specified time will be disposed of.

VI. Display Hours

1. Scientific Displays will be open for viewing during hours specified by the Annual Meeting Program Committee.

VII. Liability

1. The displayer shall assume all responsibility for their display. **The MSRT is not responsible for any loss or damage.** Every effort will be made to assure the safety of your display.

VIII. Judging

1. Selection of Judges will be made by the Scientific Display Chairperson. Judges names shall only be known only by the Scientific Display Chairperson. The number of judges shall be at least three, but more may be added at the discretion of the Scientific Display Chairperson.
2. Judging criteria shall be based on the judging format
